## Saint Vincent's Corner

### **St. Vincent de Paul Needs You!**

*Did you know?* The Santa Rosa Vincentians distribute nearly 13,000 lbs. of food each month to area families through our two monthly pantries, during our monthly Groceries-On-Wheels program and, during the school year, through our FISS Food for Families program.

Most of the groceries are purchased from the Central Texas Food Bank. The Food Bank delivers them to The Caring Place on the Monday before the first Wednesday and the third Monday of each month. Vincentians meet in The Caring Place parking lot at @7:15 AM on those days to receive the groceries and load them into their vehicles. The groceries are then driven to Carr Hall where they are unloaded and placed on the tables and shelves. From start to finish this is about a 2-3 hour task.

The logistics of moving such a large quantity of groceries has become a challenge for our membership. We are seeking assistance from able-bodied parishioners to help us in this endeavor. This is a great opportunity for individuals who want to give back to our community; but, don't have the time for a larger commitment.
