### Saint Vincent's Corner

On Monday, August 14, Mike Judice, Grand Knight of the Santa Rosa Knights of Columbus, presented your Santa Rosa Vincentians with a check for \$6,500 to be used for school supplies and Coats for Kids. The Knights collected this money through their annual "Spare Change Drive". We wish to thank the KCs and all who participated in this fundraiser for this awesome donation. Your generosity continues to amaze us.

One thing we learned last year is that many of the adults we visit need coats, too. *Do you have a closet full of coats that you don't know what to do with?* We can help. **Please bring us your gently-used coats.** We will get them cleaned and redistribute them to our neighbors in need. You can **bring them to Carr Hall on Monday, August 21 from 5 PM – 8 PM**, or Tuesday, September 5 from 9 AM – noon, **Or bring them to the RE Library on Thursday, September 7 from 6:30 PM – 8 PM** or Thursday, September 21 from 6:30 PM – 8 PM. *If these times don't work for you please call our service number and we'll arrange a way to get them.*

Beginning in September, Vincentians will be packing bags of 6-8 shelf-stable items and transporting them to Florence schools each month. Because of its nutritional value, peanut butter is included in every bag, every month. **We welcome donations of 16 – 18 oz jars of creamy peanut butter, any brand.** Our "peanut butter shelf" is in the vestibule of church. We also collect Campbell's labels and Box Tops-for-Education for FID. They can be placed in the box on the "peanut butter shelf."

Those needing assistance should call our **service number, 254.317.2891**. A trained Vincentian will answer or call back to conduct an initial intake. Following the intake process, two Vincentians will conduct a home visit to determine how we may best assist. Foremost for all Vincentians is that we

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see Jesus in those we visit and that our neighbors in need see the light of Jesus in us. Our goal on a home visit is to alleviate suffering, to lift up our neighbors, and to help restore their dignity all in the name of Jesus. Information obtained during calls and visits is confidential. If you are **hearing the call to serve Christ** by serving your brothers and sisters, please consider joining us. We have a number of different volunteer opportunities. Our next meeting is Thursday, September 7 at 6:30 PM in the RE Library.
