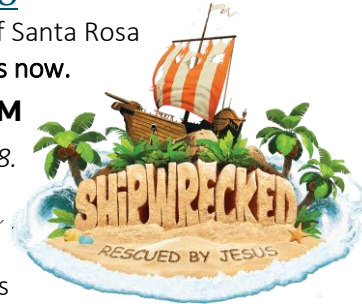

## Saint Vincent's Corner

This month our Conference members met with a lady who was requesting assistance on behalf of a couple living in our parish boundaries. The couple, both in their mid-80's, received a letter from their bank threatening repossession of their only vehicle because of two missed payments. The car, purchased 5+ years ago when their financial situation was much better, is due to be paid off in April. Unfortunately, the youngest son in the family recently got into legal trouble and the couple expended their resources assisting him.

Vincetians met with the family and together came up with several forms of assistance. We signed them up for our "Groceries-On-Wheels" program and the food pantry which will free up some of their Social Security money to pay bills. We have contacted Texas Ramps, a statewide nonprofit, to repair the rickety back stairs and the Sertoma Club to assist with hearing aids. We encouraged the eldest daughter to seek help from the other children who were unaware of the situation. We paid \$900 on the car note and the family came up with the remainder so that payments are now current.

Last week we received a letter from the couple. It starts out, *"God bless you! Thank you, thank you. I was at a point I didn't know where to turn...All our lives we have been on the giving end, never on the receiving end. I love to give, but it is so hard to receive...God has been and is so good to us."*

And this last part of the letter is especially to you, our generous supporters of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, who make our Mission possible.

*"I cannot ever thank you enough for your help...May God richly bless your lives as you work for Him...Thank you so very much for your wonderful generosity. God surely will bless you all for your help."*
